2. Discuss and consider quotes received for the purchase of vests and weapons for the Police Department and take possible action to approve purchase from a selected vendor.
3. Discuss and consider quotes for the purchase of a turbidimeter for the Water Treatment Plant, and take possible action to authorize its purchase.
4. Discuss and approval authorizing Jorge Galvan to attend the Customer Service Inspections Course (online, June 30–July 1, 2026, \$400) to comply with TCEQ requirements and take possible action.
5. Discussion and approval authorizing Andrew Saucedo to attend the 2026 Basic Water Works Operations Course (June 30–July 2, 2026, \$375) and take possible action.
