

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF TRASH AND OTHER WASTE MATERIAL IN THE CITY OF LYFORD; PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF OFFENSIVE SMELLING MATERIALS AT ANY TIME; PROVIDING FOR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION; PROVIDING FOR PARTIAL INVALIDITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LYFORD, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

Except for cotton gins and cotton seed oil mills, it shall hereafter be illegal for any person, firm or corporation to burn trash, waste or other materials within the City of Lyford.

SECTION II.

The provisions of this ordinance do not in any manner alter or repeal the provisions of any ordinance or ordinances regulating the burning of any substance by cotton gins and cotton seed oil mills, and it is especially provided that the ordinance regulating said concerns shall continue in full force and effect and are not changed or repealed by this ordinance.

SECTION III.

Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance or any part thereof shall be fined not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION IV.

That if any portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portions of same shall, nevertheless, be valid.

SECTION V.



Second Reading passed and approved on this the 12th day of September, 2005.


