Must have 8 years of Tier 3 experience.

Must be able to operate small engine machineries such as Zero turn riding mower, tractor, and shredder. Needs experience and knowledge in the groundskeeping and landscaping. Must have some knowledge of plumbing, electrical, woodwork, and welding experience. Must be trained and certified by Supervisor on the following machinery: be able to operate a Backhoe, Dump Truck, and attend training on Chemical handling. To include Training in small engine repairs. To include training on inventory, preventive maintenance, and maintain daily logs. Must have the ability to operate and train on the use of a Boom Lift. Must be able to operate the Backhoe, and dump truck and attend training on Chemical handling. Must have Computer experience and understanding of software to create tables, and spreadsheets and communicate with another Department using a computer. Must be able to supervise and give directives to personnel within the department. Must have the ability to work with all departments. Be able to operate a Maintainer, Backhoe, Jet Cleaner, and Dump Truck and attend training on Chemical handling and have a certificate for Mosquito Spraying.

EDUCATION:

Must have a High School Diploma. Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License.

REQUIREMENTS:

Must be able to lift 50 lbs., and able to climb a step ladder. Continuous lifting of heavy materials above the head and constant physical movement which requires physical strength associated with hard labor. Employee may at times be required to work on weekends or holidays.
