

ILLEGAL DUMPING ORDINANCE NO. 05-09-12

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON, TENANT OR OCCUPANT OF ANY LOT, BUILDING OR PREMISES, IN PERSON OR BY HIS AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF ILLEGAL DUMPING OF ANY SOLID WASTE, RUBBISH, WEEDS, BRUSH CUTTINGS, OFFAL OR OTHER SUBSTANCES IN THE CITY OF LYFORD; PROVIDING FOR A FINE NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LYFORD, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person, tenant or occupant of any lot, building or premises, in person or by his agent or employee to cast, throw, drop, place, sweep or deposit, or allow to accumulate, or to allow waste or liquids from receptacles to leak or spill over, or allow the same to be done in any manner whatsoever, any solid wastes and rubbish, weeds, brush cuttings, offal or other substances or thing whatsoever of an offensive nature or deleterious to health, in or upon any street, sidewalk, park or other public place, or vacant lot or in any yard space of privately owned premises, or in or upon the waters of any canal, stream or other watercourse or public waters, or in any drain, sewer or receiving basin within the City of Lyford or in, upon or about any building or premises with the City of Lyford, except as provided in this chapter.

SECTION II.

Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance or any part thereof shall be fined not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Each day's violation hereof shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION III.

The Lyford City Commissioners find and determine that considerations relating to the public safety and welfare make it necessary to place this ordinance in effect after two readings and that this ordinance shall be effective after its passage and the publication of its caption.


